It starts with a conversation.

Talk to your health care provider and pharmacist about opioids.

Discuss the risks of using opioids and consider alternative forms of managing pain. Alternative ways of addressing pain include exercising, stretching, practicing yoga, and seeing a chiropractor.

Under Washington's "911 Good Samaritan Law," if you think someone is overdosing and you seek medical help for the victim, neither of you will be charged for possessing or using drugs.

The Good Sam Law will *not* protect you from being arrested for

- outstanding warrants
- · probation or parole violations
- drug dealing
- · crimes other than drug possession



LOCK UP YOUR MEDS

Secure medications in a locked bag, box, or other secure location.
