Be a good Samaritan!

If you suspect an opioid overdose, administer naloxone, call 911, and administer CPR.

Under Washington's "911 Good Samaritan" Law, if you think someone is **overdosing** and you seek medical help for the victim, neither of you will be charged for possessing or using drugs.

The Good Sam Law will *not* protect you from being arrested for

- outstanding warrants
- probation or parole violations
- drug dealing
- crimes other than drug possession
